b When you restore the images that have been changed, you will see three options, as shown in Figure 11-19. The first option will result in files being modified. The second option will result in overwriting the file, and the third option will result in the file being skipped. You can restore an entire folder or only specific files. Figure 11-19: Decide how to restore the images from the i Incubator folder in iTunes. Your iPhone will try to recover the items, and you may or may not see a message about the recovery being complete. You can check the status of the recovery by opening iTunes and selecting your iPhone from the Devices list in the left pane. If the Status of your iPhone is Recovery, then you have successfully restored from your previous backup. If you see Recovery Status of the iPhone, then you can close the window and check your iPhone for status information. You can also check the recovery status by going to Settings, General, and Backup, and see if there is a button that allows you to reset your iPhone. If you see that, you can reset the iPhone to factory settings. If you don't see the button, then try the following: 1. Go to Settings, General, and Reset. 2. Select Erase All Content and Settings. 3. Press the Back button. 4. Select Restore from iCloud. 5. Select the iPhone to which you want to restore from. 6. Wait for the restore to complete. Troubleshooting iPhones When restoring from an iPhone, there are two common problems you may see: Restoring the Wrong Phone You may have backed up your iPhone and then connected your laptop to iTunes and selected Restore from the devices list. The problem you may see is that you are backing up an iPhone and selecting the computer that you want to restore from. The problem is that you need to select the correct phone number and press the Restore button. To help with the problem, the next section will walk you through the process. Corrupt Backup The problem you may see is that you have corrupted your iPhone backup. If you have used a version of iTunes that doesn't use the .ipsw file format for the backups, then you may see that when you plug in your iPhone and launch iTunes, it asks you to 82157476af
